### ***Happenings Around the Diocese*** ***Catholic Charities Wayne County***

Exciting things are happening at Catholic Charities Wayne County! They recently teamed up with SNAP to provide nutrition classes for dual diagnosis individuals ages 10-18. These classes included nutrition education, activities to get the kids moving as well as preparing healthy snacks they could enjoy at the end of class.

Some of the adult individuals will be participating in the upcoming cooking matters classes. The Cooking Matters program is a 6 week commitment for the participants and involves them actually learning how to do the food preparation with hands on experience in the class. It is a 2 hour weekly program. They will



prepare recipes, eat a meal together and receive nutrition and food safety information.

They will receive groceries at each class to take home with them so that they can prepare the same recipe at home for themselves and/or their families. At the end of the 6 week program, they receive a certificate of completion and have received training in cutting techniques, food safety, reading and interpreting recipes, making spice mixtures, cooking techniques and much more.

Next up in Wayne County - They would like to team up with the Wayne County Board of DD to put on a community dance event.
